Terms of Reference of the Commission

To examine the state of urbanization in Rajasthan with reference to demographic, economic, socio-psychological, infrastructural, land & shelter, environmental, climatic, energy, transportation & communication, cultural & heritage, aesthetic, technological and related aspects:

To review status of various policies, programmes, major (ii) projects in the State having bearing on urban development /urbanization.

- (iii) To review status of various Acts, laws bylaws in the State having bearing on urban development/ urbanization.
- (iv) To identify priority action areas, make projections of future needs, cornfulate and recommend basic guidelines for the specific action plan in each of the identified priority action areas:
- (v) To evolve and recommend policy framework and suggest basic approaches & water efficient, climate friendly alternative patterns of urbanisation and New Age urbanism leading to creation of towns and cities which are physically fit, safe and disaster resistant, economically viable, socially cohesive, inclusive and just, environmentally sustainable, aesthetically pleasing intellectually stimulating and spritually satisfying;
- (vi) To recommend an institutional framework for monitoring the effective implementation of the Commission's recommendations; and
- (vii) To consider any other matter having a bearing on urbanisation and make suitable recommendations thereon.

The Commission will visit different parts of the State & Country as and when needed, will commission in depth research studies and will constitute working groups of specialists to examine critical areas of concern. The Commission may invite other officers/specialists in its meetings as and when needed and may invite suggestions from the public on various aspects of urbanisation.

The entire expenditure on the establishment and functioning of the Commission shall be borne by Jaipur Development Authority. The Commission will give its report in a year's time.

Department of Urban Development and Housing, Government of Rajasthan will be the Nodal Department for the Commission.
